Corazon C. Aquino by virtue of Presidential Proclamation 44 moved NBW to the last week of January and National Bible Sunday on the last Sunday of January every year. Then, Pres. Fidel V. Ramos declared Presidential Proclamation 1067 with emphasis on the importance of reading and studying the Bible in molding the spiritual, moral, and social fiber of the Filipino people. Then, Pres. Rodrigo R. Duterte through Presidential Proclamation 124 declares January as the National Bible Month. Moreover, the 17th Congress of the Philippines declared the last Monday of January every year as a special working holiday in observance of the National Bible Day by virtue of Republic Act 11163.


This only proves the timeless truth: *"the word of the LORD abides forever"* (Isaiah 40:8b and 1 Peter 1:24b).


